

TALL SHIP SAILING

Nothing beats a day out sailing aboard a dramatic, beautiful Tall Ship; helping the crew sail the ship or simply relaxing on deck with a glass of Champagne. Followed by a seated evening meal onboard or an informal barbecue or buffet: the choice is yours.



- Location: Solent
- Embark at either Portsmouth or Southampton
- Full or half day options
- Structured programmes where the team sails, trains and runs the whole ship in watches can be developed to your specifications
- On board are saloons that make good feasting, meeting and prize giving venues. There is also the option of staying overnight in the ship's cabins



Suggested itinerary:

- 10.00 Guests are welcomed on board the ship and coffee and pastries are served
- 10.15 Safety briefing and then the group is put into "watches" and given tuition on basic rules
- 10.30 The ship leaves the quay and heads out into the Solent
- 11.00 The morning is spent learning "the ropes" and the terminology of sailing a tall ship
- 13.00 The watch takes it's turn to enjoy a hearty buffet lunch served in the saloon
- 14.30 As the "new recruits" become accustomed to life on board, the captain calls all hands on deck and introduces some more advanced maneuvers to challenge the team
- 16.30 The ship returns to the dock, afternoon tea is served and guests disembark
